Inauguration of the first batch of candidates for FY 2019-20

A batch of candidates undergoing skill training in Customer Care Executive (CCE) was inaugurated on 9th July 2019 at Chabua, Dibrugarh District in presence of Shri Dilip K Bhuyan, GM-Public Affairs, Shri T Hazarika, DGM-(CSR & CC) and officials from M/s Gram Tarang, Guwahati which is one of the implementing partner of project OIL Swabalamban.

Since 2013-14, under CSR Project Swabalamban, OIL has trained 14,855 and placed 11,771 candidates from various parts of Assam with maximum number of candidates from OIL's operational areas of Upper Assam. In FY 2018-19, the trades offered were Food & Beverages, Electrician, General Duty Assistant, Industrial Sewing, House Keeping & Hospitality, BPO and Industrial Fitter.

This year, OIL has targeted to train over 2700 nos. of youths under Swabalamban. In addition to the previously ongoing trades, new trades like Radiology, Refractionist and Automotive Technician is being introduced.
