A post-graduate in Geology from Madras Presidency College, he is also accredited with a Ph.D from the premier institute IIT Roorkee on the subject "Petroleum Prospect and Risk Evaluation". Dr. Chandrasekaran started his career with ONGC at Mumbai as an Operations Geologist in 1984.
