

A pilot intervention was launched on 19th Dec, 2022 under OILCSR flagship project OIL Jeevika to be implemented in OIL's operational areas of Hapjan and Guijan Development Blocks in Tinsukia district. The launch program was graced by Shri Prasanta Borkakoti, RCE, OIL, Shri S K Baruah, Executive Director, NEDFI, Dr Gautam Saikia, Professor and program coordinator, Small Tea Growers Advisory Program, Dr Nilim Kalita, Citrus Research Station, Shri Simanta Saikia, Director, Spices Board, Shri RCM Reddy, MD of Schoolnet India Limited and other officials from Oil India Limited.

The pilot sustainable cluster-based intervention will be implemented by OIRDS in 14 villages identified based on a socioeconomic study covering 775 households. ### **LAUNCH OF HARBEST**

OIL CSR launched brand **Harbest (Best of Harvest)** under Project OIL Jeevika at Indian Institute of Entrepreneurship, Guwahati, Assam, India as a sustainable livelihood intervention for people living in the Diyun Circle, Changlang District, Arunachal Pradesh.

Harbest was launched by Shri Harish Madhav, Director-Fin & Director-HR (I/C) with Shri Gagann Jain, Member of Board level CSR and SD Committee and Independent Director, Shri Prasanta Borkakoty, RCE, Dr Lalit Sharma, Director-IIE, Dr Sriparna Baruah, Head-CIE.

Harbest meaning "Best of Harvest" has been developed for identification of the products made by the people of Diyun under OIL Jeevika along with specific packaging. All the products have been tested for their nutrition quotient along with the FSSAI license.

The product basket in Harbest includes Honey, Bee Wax, Mustard Oil, Mustard Cake, Buckwheat Flour, Green Gram, Ginger Powder, Turmeric Powder, Tea, Amla, Banana Chips, Jackfruit Chips, Elephant Apple Powder, Black Pepper and Khamti Lahi rice.
